## WHAT IS IT?

Hyde Park Baseball Camp is designed to teach beginner and intermediate baseball players the fundamentals of the game. For more experienced players, the camp will provide individual instruction as well as a challenging environment to touch up the fundamentals. This camp provides 4 days and over 16 hours of fast paced, intense, ability-age-grouped instruction emphasizing a positive approach to competition. Campers get skill and drill practice, lots of game time and competition activities. Kids will participate in a nurturing atmosphere that will encourage and teach them Christian values in a competitive environment.

## WHERE AND WHEN?

There will be one camp held this year at the Hyde Park Quarries Campus. The address is 11400 N. Mopac Expressway Austin Texas 78759. Sessions are Monday - Thursday beginning at 8:30 am and are completed each day at 12:30 pm **June 8 - 11**. Camp will end Thursday after the awards ceremony that begins at 1: 00 pm. Late registration and check-in will begin Monday, June 8 at 8:00 am.

## WHO FOR?

All boys entering the **3<sup>rd</sup> grade, up through those entering the 6<sup>th</sup> grade.**

## WHAT IS OFFERED?

All campers will receive a camp t-shirt, hat, certificate, and personal evaluation. Coaches will include Hyde Park Men's Athletic Director and Head Baseball Coach S.L. Bradley, Varsity Pitching Coach Chris Coy who also coaches for the W.I.N.G.S. premier baseball program of Austin. Varsity Assistant and First Base Coach David Alexander, as well as current players in the Hyde Park program. The Hyde Park Baseball team has had a history of success in central Texas high school baseball making the State Playoffs 6 straight seasons.
